



CHALLENGES I NOTICED



Lack of Network

- Developers and DB admins were working in silos
- No space to share PostgreSQL experiences or ask questions
- No local mentors or PostgreSQL « champions » to lead the way

Isolation

- Those interested in PostgreSQL felt alone
- No community to validate or encourage their learning
- Hard to stay motivated without feedback or peer support

Limited Exposure to Open Source Culture


- Community contribution to felt far away
- No events to connect Malagasy developers to the global open-source movement








What we learned

Positive impact	Notes
The friendly and inclusive vibe	People felt welcomed, even first-timers
Seeing local speakers on stage	Inspired others to believe « I can do this too »
Live demos and beginner-friendly sessions	Simple language, live example, local use cases
Networking opportunities	Breaks and casual discussions were highly valued

 What we can Improve	
Challenge	Action next time
Some talks ran long	Add a timekeeper
Wi-Fi issue	Have a backup plan
Some people / companies did not hear about the event	Start earlier with promotion, contact partners directly
No livestream / No replay	Record sessions




